

Literacy

We will be looking at non-fiction by writing diary entries for our scientific observations and writing instructions for planting seeds and bulbs.

We will be exploring twists on Traditional Tales with a focus on using expanded noun phrases, uplevelling our sentences and adding suffixes.

Science

Using the story of Jack and the Beanstalk we will be using our skills of scientific inquiry to explore what plants need for growth and survival. We will be identifying and naming a range of plants. Naming the basic parts of a plant by dissecting a common house plant and planning investigations. We will be looking at animals and their offspring and what they need to grow and survive.
