OUR ROUTINES

When sitting on the carpet

- *We sit still with our legs crossed and our hands clasped together.*
- *We put our hands up when we want to speak.*
- *We listen to the adult and each other.*
- *We listen with our whole body.*

When working in class

- *We work quietly, with focus and we do not get distracted.*
- *We stop immediately when our teacher indicates.*
- *We work together as a team.*
- *We always try our very best.*

When we play outside

- *We are good friends and play together*
- *When an adult asks us to stop, we stop immediately and wait for instructions, one behind the other in a straight line.*
- *We share our equipment and take very good care of it.*
- *We always look where we are going.*
- *When we are finished using something, we put it back in the correct place.*

OUR RULES

OUR COMMUNICATION RULE

- One person speaks at a time
- We use our quiet voices when working
- We stay in our seats and put our hands up if we want to speak to an adult.
- If our adult has to speak to a visitor, we do not interrupt but remain silent.
- We speak positively

OUR LEARNING RULE

- We always try our very best
- If we are unsure, we try our best and then we can ask an adult for help.
- We look at our friends for good examples
- We listen at all times so that we do not miss important information and instructions

OUR MOVEMENT RULE

- We always walk in school.
- We listen to adults and do as they say.
- We let adults go through doors or past us first.
- We hold the door open for our friends and especially for other adults in school.

OUR SAFETY RULE

- To walk sensibly in school and move around carefully outside
- We do not open any outside doors without a teacher
- We listen carefully and answer sensibly during register
- We carry equipment carefully and pick things up if they fall on the floor.

CLASS MEETINGS/CIRCLE TIME

We will be given an opportunity to discuss and express relevant issues and concerns during group and class circle times. This will be supported by Mrs Brennan, our school Learning mentor.

CONSEQUENCES

- 1) We will be reminded of our rules and look at a demonstration from a friend.

- 3) We will have some 'Thinking Time'.
- 4) We will be sent to a different class
- 5) We will be sent to see Mrs Gaffney.
- 6) Our teacher will speak to our parents.
