Re: Key Stage 2 SATs, End of Year Production and Robin Wood

Please find below the timetable for the Key Stage 2 SATs tests, commencing Monday 13th May. We wish all our children the very best for SATs week. No matter what the results of the tests, we are extremely proud of all our children and of all their hard work and efforts.

I would like to take this opportunity of thanking you all for the hard work and commitment shown this year by everyone. As a school we very much appreciate the tremendous support and effort, which has assisted in supporting the in-school organisation and teaching.

We will be providing breakfast each morning for the Year 6 children in the library from 8:30am, followed by a "relaxation session". We ask that as many children as possible take up the offer of joining us, as this is part of our preparation and something children have enjoyed in previous years.

Tests will be administered as follows:

Monday 13 th May, 2019	Key stage 2 English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling test, Paper 1, short answer questions. Key Stage 2 English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling test, Paper 2 Spelling.
Tuesday 14 th May, 2019	Key stage 2 English Reading
Wednesday 15 th May, 2019	Key stage 2 Mathematics, Paper 1 Arithmetic test Key stage 2 Mathematics, Paper 2 Reasoning
Thursday 16 th May, 2019	Key stage 2 mathematics, Paper 3 Reasoning

Robin Wood 2019

Children attending Robin Wood should arrive at school on Friday 17th May in their own clothes at the usual time. Staff will then aim to head off for approximately 9:30am, aiming to arrive at Robin Wood for 10:20am. Staff will be leaving Robin Wood at 2pm-2:15pm on Sunday 19th May, aiming to be back at St Anne's for approximately 3pm. If we experience any problems with traffic, Mr Liddell will make contact and I will put it on the school Twitter account (@StAnnesRC1)!

There are still families yet to pay for the Robin Wood trip. By lunchtime of **Thursday 16th May** all balances will be checked. If there are still outstanding balances by then, your child will not be able to attend the trip.

*Spending money is limited to £5.

*Any medication, including travel sickness tablets, must be in a sealed and named bag (along with instructions) and given to Mr Liddell before the trip (ideally on the Friday morning). Please ensure if your child does suffer from travel sickness that they take their medication ahead of the outward journey!

*Children are not permitted to bring any food on the trip.

*No electrical equipment is allowed. This includes mobile phones, tablets, and hairdryers. This also now includes disposable cameras. Staff will take photographs of all children and these will be placed in their Records of Achievement. If staff have any concerns about your child, Mr Liddell will contact you from Robin Wood.

*It would be a good idea to label clothes with your child's name!

On Monday 20th May, following the trip, children are usually extremely tired. It is an option for them to arrive in school to be registered by 10:30am. If they arrive before this time, they will be awarded both marks for the day.
