Dear Parents/Carers,

Due to school closure, home learning online resources have been set up (see reverse for extra guidance) to support you to work with your child at home.

I want to share the following information about the school day and the areas of the curriculum we cover which may help you to shape your day whilst your child/ren are home learning.

KS1- 8:55am to 3:15pm

Learning becomes more structured.

Breaks- 10:30am- 10:45am, lunch 11:45- 1pm, 2:30-2:45pm

Reading: Hear your child read daily wherever possible. Read a story to your child daily wherever possible.

Writing: Practise writing and phonics daily.

Maths: Daily, supported by what is in your child's year group online folder, Times Table Rockstars and My Maths online.

RE: 2 hours a week. We teach children about our Catholic Faith. They learn about the bible, God the father, the son and the Holy Spirit, the work of important religious people eg St Peter and how to be kind, compassionate and forgiving. We also learn about other faiths.

Our current focus is Lent and Easter.

PE: 2 hours of exercise a week at least, preferably some exercise daily.

Other Subjects: Science, history or geography, Art or DT, music and PSHE

We teach the daily subjects in the morning and the weekly subjects in the afternoon.

As we are moving into something very different in the weeks ahead, there may be days where learning is not your priority. This we understand. We pray that you stay well, and we hope you find time to have fun and enjoy each other. There may be activities that you think of that your children will enjoy. Feel free to include these in the work you send back to school when we re-open. This could be a photograph or a short-written celebration describing what you have done.
