- Help everybody, especially if they are hurt!
- Try our best to make everybody feel happy!
- Always try our best in everything we do

OUR ROUTINES

- *When sitting in our places*
 - We put our hands up when we want to speak.
 - We listen to the adult and to each other.
 - We look with our eyes at the teacher when they are speaking.
- *When working in class*
 - We work quietly, with focus and we do not get distracted.
 - We stop as soon as our teacher says.
 - We work together as a team.
 - We always try our very best.
 - We do not get out of our places.
- *When playing outside*
 - We are good friends and play together nicely.
 - We take very good care of our equipment.
 - We show a good example to other children.
 - When an adult asks us to stop, we stop immediately and wait to be told to line up quietly, one behind the other in a straight line.
 - We share our equipment.

OUR COMMUNICATION RULE

Only one person speaks at a time.

We use a quiet voice when working if we need to.

We put our hand up and wait when we want to speak to an adult.

If our teacher must speak to a visitor in our room, we do not interrupt but remain quiet.

We speak positively and use only kind words.

OUR LEARNING RULE

We always try our very best.

We have a 'I can do it' attitude.

If we are unsure, we try our best, we can use the resources, our friends and our teacher to help us.

To look at our friends for good examples.

To listen at all times so that we do not miss important information and instructions.

OUR PROBLEM-SOLVING RULE

To ask a friend.

To use the resources in class to help us.

To talk to an adult.

OUR MOVEMENT RULE

To always walk in school.

To listen to adults and do as they say.

We let adults go through doors or past us first.

We hold the door open for our friends and especially for other adults in school.

OUR SAFETY RULE

To walk sensibly in school and move carefully when we are outside.

We do not open any outside doors without a teacher.

We listen carefully and answer sensibly during register.

To pick things up off the floor.

To carry equipment carefully.

To not swing on our chairs.

Resolution and Consequences:

- We will have time to calm down and reflect on what has happened.
- We will revisit our class rules.
- We will be sent to see another teacher, if necessary.
- We will speak with Miss Nally or Mrs Duffy.
- Our teacher will speak with our grown-ups.
- A restorative discussion with the adults/children involved will be had to resolve any disputes positively and fairly.
