Florence's dad and his team from Fire and Rescue Service came to school. It is such a fascinating, challenging and rewarding career!

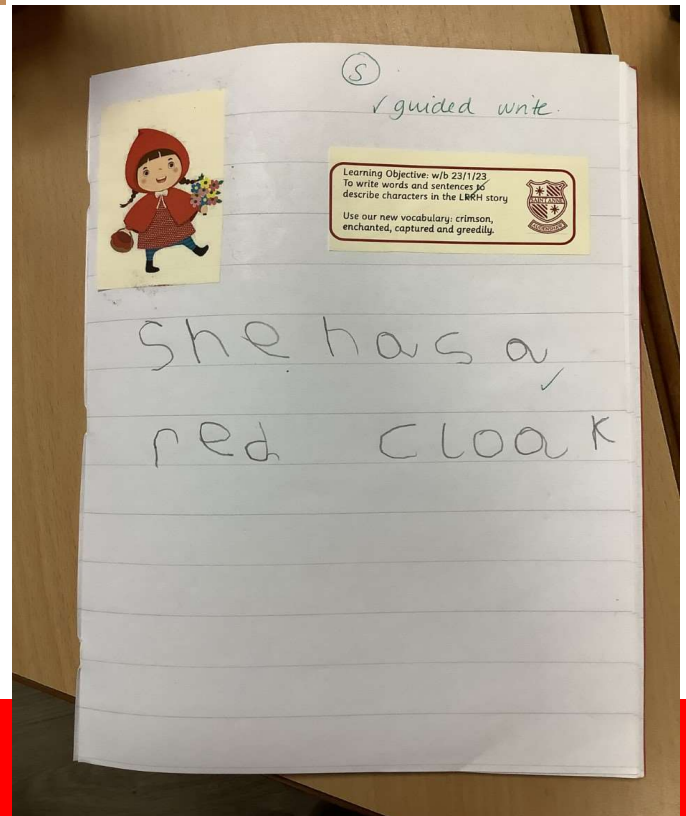
