#### Our Communication Rules

### Our Learning Rules

- When we are finding things difficult, we will ask for help

### Our Problem Solving Rules

- We will use our Growth Mindset learning powers to overcome any challenges that we face
- We will always try our best and have a go ourselves; if we are still unsure, we will then ask a neighbour or the teacher
- ♣ We will use displays and resources around the classroom to support our learning. E.g. thesaurus, dictionary and word banks

#### Our Movement Rules

- When the bell rings, on the playground, we will stop and listen to instructions
- We will enter school sensibly and quietly after break and lunch times (in our line order)

#### Our Safety Rule

- ♣ We will always tuck our chairs under the tables and keep surfaces clear

- ♣ We will be quiet and follow instructions when the fire alarm rings
