Football



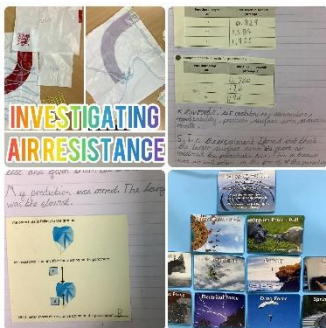
On Tuesday, our footballers from Year 6 and Year 3 made us so proud with their determination and team spirit.
