### Year Four visit The People's History Museum



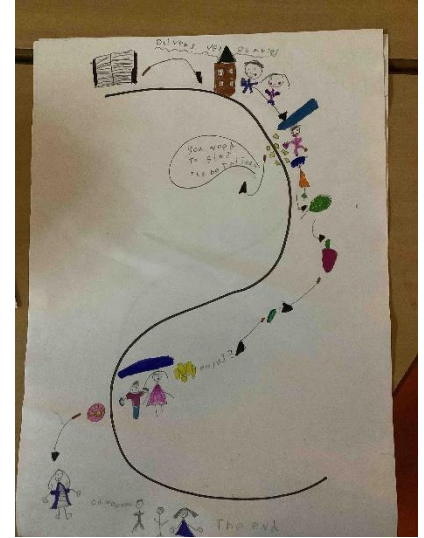
