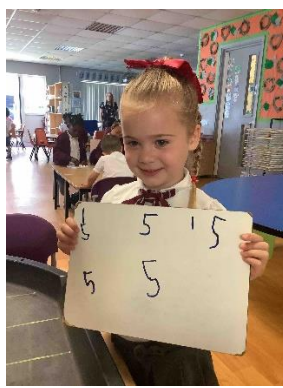
Holy Communion Celebration
