Writing/Phonics:

In English we are focussing on the story 'Wherever Next', exploring the story, retelling the story, writing sentences and captions to describe the story and creating our own space that we can describe using exciting adjectives.

We will continue to follow the 'Little Wandle' reading programme.

Your child will bring a new reading book home every Thursday.

Maths:

We will be focussing on:

- Place Value within 10
- Addition and subtraction within 10

History / Geography:

History is our focus this half term. We will be learning about 'toys from the past'.

The children will be:

- Creating timelines
- Comparing old toys to new toys

RE:

We will be learning about The Creation Story. Focussing on how God made the world, animals, plants, day, night and people in seven special days.

Science:

Our topic this half term is 'The Human Body'.

We will be learning all about our amazing bodies and how they work. Together, we will explore our five senses – sight, hearing, touch, taste, and smell – and discover which body parts help us to use them.

PE:

The children will take part in 'Dance' this half term.
