Year Four

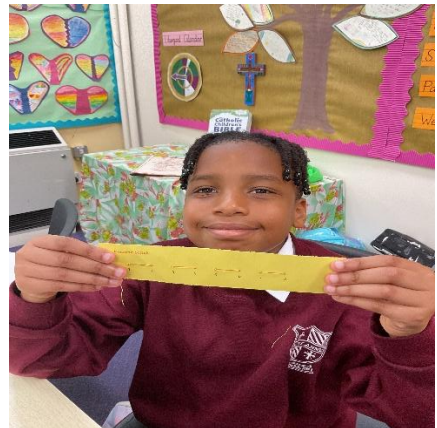
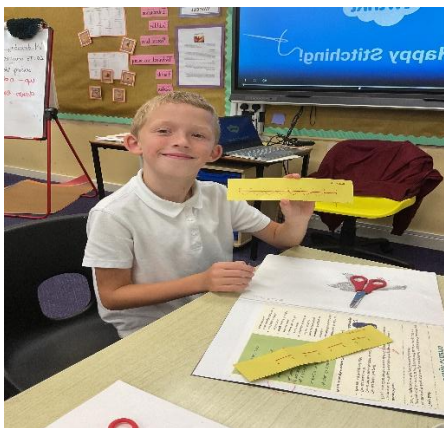

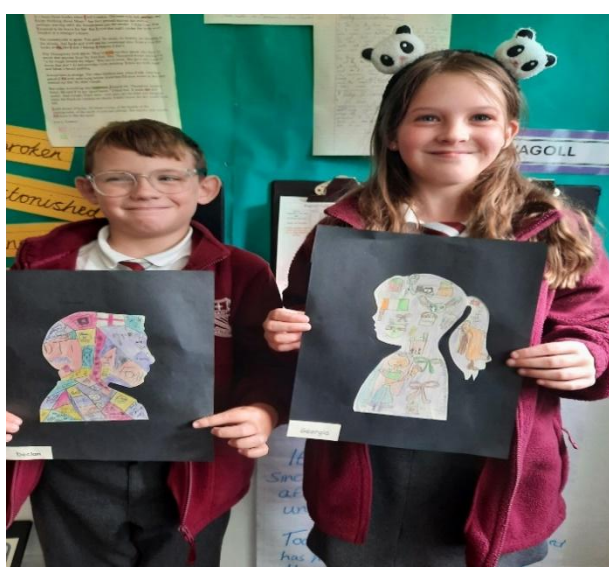
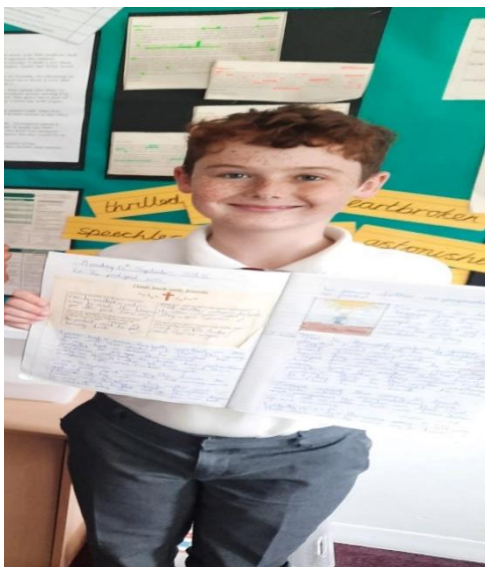
Year Five
