Nursery have been busy learning all about Chinese New Year and we enjoyed exploring the traditions and celebrations together.



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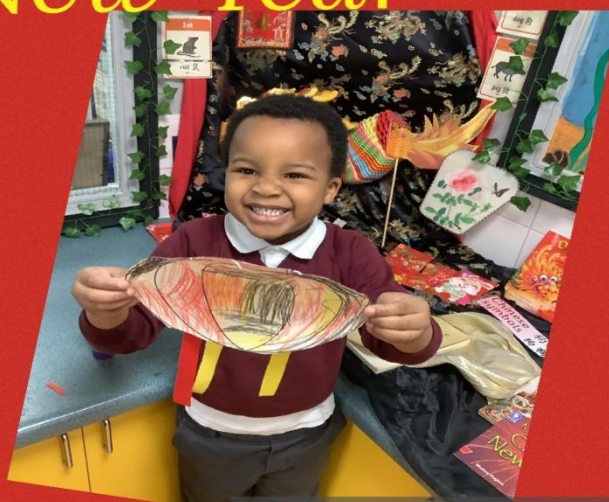


Reception

The Year Five prayer leaders led a Celebration of the Word, reflecting on Matthew 5:13–15. We reflected on how we can enrich and brighten the lives of others.



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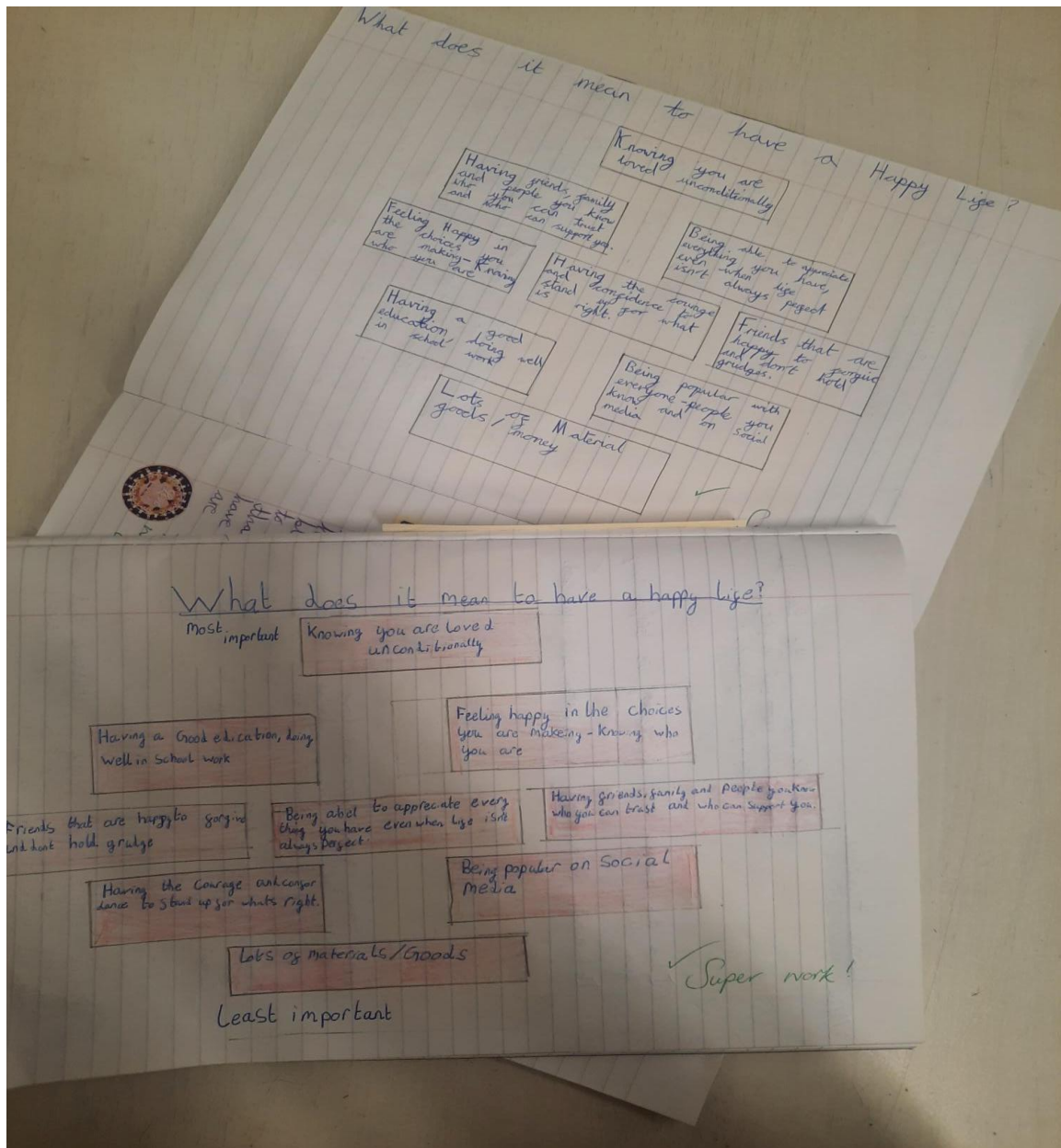
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Year Six
