English

This half term we will be focusing on the text *A Tiger Who Came to Tea* by Judith Kerr, recapping Year 1 writing expectations including punctuation and conjunctions. We will then move on to *'The Way Back Home'* by Oliver Jeffers writing a narrative.

Mathematics

In Maths this half term, we are revisiting place value and stretching our knowledge of number to numbers within 100. We will be looking at partitioning numbers and writing numbers in both numerals and word form.

R.E

In RE, we are looking at Creation and Covenant. In this topic, we look at Genesis and God as the Creator. We will explore God's special promises (covenant) to all living creatures and our duty as stewards of God's world.

History

In History this half term, we are exploring the topic of 'Man on the Moon'. We will be finding out who the first people in space were, and why Neil Armstrong is remembered today.

Science - We are exploring what animals live on Earth and the different categories we can sort them into. We will also touch on habitats and where these animals live.

In PE this half term, we are looking at 'Fitness and Fundamentals'. In this unit, children will be explore agility, co-ordination, speed and stamina whilst developing their fundamental movement skills.
