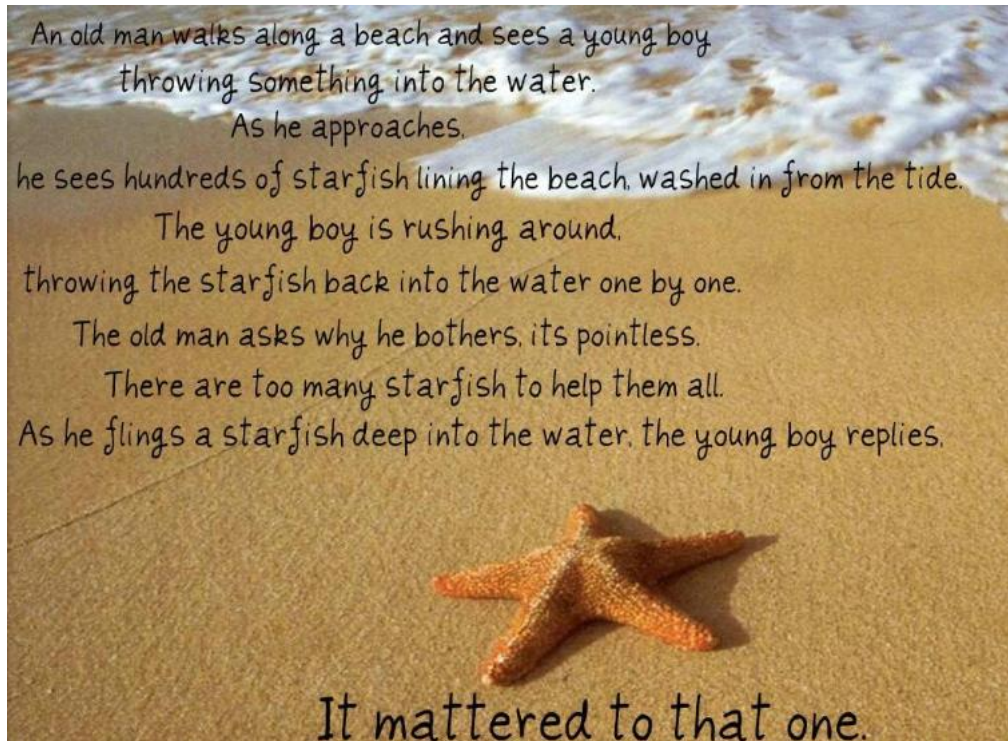
“Following in Jesus’ Footsteps with Love in Our Hearts”

Year Two

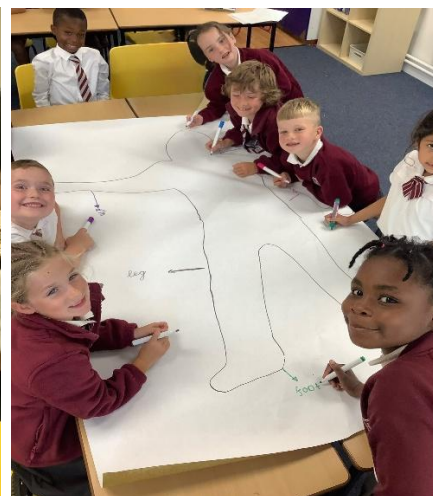
