Year Four



English

This term, our class text is *Stitch Head*. Inspired by the spooky setting in the story, we will be writing non-chronological reports about monsters, exploring their appearance, habitat, powers, and unique characteristics.

Mathematics

This term we will be learning about place value, addition, and multiplication. We will explore numbers up to 10,000, understand the value of each digit, and practise rounding and comparing large numbers. We will also use formal written methods to add and subtract numbers.

RE

This term we will be exploring the branch *Creation and Covenant*. We will learn about the Abraham's story in Genesis and how it shows how to have trust and faith in God. We will also explore how the virtues of faith, hope and love help them to be a good neighbour. Also we will make links between prayers that show trust in God and the virtues of faith, hope, and love.

History

This term, we will be learning about the Anglo Saxons and their impact on Britain. We will explore a range of sources- including images, artefacts and books- to find out about life in Anglo Saxon times and what it was like to live in Britain during this historical period. We will investigate the types of food, culture, clothing, housing, leisure activities during Anglo Saxon times and compare their life to the life of an Anglo-Saxon child.

Science

We will be learning how to group and classify living things.

PE

This half term we will focus on dodgeball and outdoor adventure activities.

French

We will be recapping previous learning taught in year 3. Such as greetings, feelings and numbers.

Music

This term we will be starting our musical journey learning how to play the violin.
