Year Three

English

We will be using the book 'Tell Me a Dragon' by Jackie Morris, as a creative stimulus for our writing. We will explore the language and imagery in the text to inspire our own poems. We will also look at the book 'Stone Age Boy' and use the text to inspire our diary entry writing.

Maths

This half term, we will be learning all about place value, looking at hundreds, tens and ones. We'll practise reading, writing, ordering and comparing numbers up to 1,000, as well as finding 10 and 100 more or less.

RE

This half term, our topic is 'Creation and Covenant.' We'll be learning about God's creation and the special relationship, or covenant, between God and his people. We'll explore the Creation story and think about how we can care for God's world and each other.

History

We'll be finding out what life was like from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We'll explore how people lived, what they ate, the homes they built, the tools they used and how life changed over time.

Science

We will be learning about biology, focusing on our skeleton and how our bodies move. We'll find out about bones, muscles and joints, and explore how they work together to help us move.

PE

We'll develop our running, jumping, throwing and catching skills, while building our coordination, balance and confidence.

French

We will be learning:
- greetings and names
- all about France

Music

We'll explore music from the Stone Age and learn how people may have used rhythm and sound. We'll create and perform our own music using voices, body percussion and instruments.

PSHE/RSE

We will be focusing on who we are, what makes us special and how we can build positive relationships with others.

Computing

We will be learning how computers connect and communicate with each other and how information is shared.

Art/DT

We'll learn what illustration is and how pictures can be used to tell and bring stories to life.
